Kitchen/Dining extension to a 15th Century thatched cottage within a Conservation Area

## DESIGN SUMMARY

This modest sized cottage located within the Conservation Area suffered from issues with maintenance and damp as well as the living accommodation being relatively dark and cramped.

This scheme addressed these issues as well as significantly enhancing the standard of living accommodation for our client. Natural daylight is maximised by the large roof lantern and large expanse of glazing to the rear which facilitates views to the rear garden. This new open plan space has become the hub of the home.

The extension fits cohesively with the existing building. Its impact upon the Conservation Area is negligible both in terms of appearance and scale.
