Transformation of 1950's bungalow

DESIGN SUMMARY

The existing house was in poor condition and lacked any architectural merit. It was, however, situated on a large and attractive plot of land with the rear of the house looking out over farmland.

The site is within the greenbelt which limits the size of any additions to the building. Offsetting the size of outbuildings on the plot enabled us to extend the house to incorporate the accommodation required.

This included a large rear suite of living areas linking into the family/kitchen room incorporating a vaulted roof and first floor mezzanine. All of the ground and first floor rooms open out on to the rear garden and large patio area. The master bedroom is separated from the main building with a first floor glazed link between the two.

The result is a spacious, contemporary and flexible family home that relates well to the garden and surrounding countryside. A true transformation.
